Please adopt a project:

1. Freshen-up building interiors and exteriors for upcoming events.
2. Ensure that camp is fully mowed. Mowers / Bush-hogging tractors needed.
3. Pick up debris and place on burn pile.
4. Clean undergrowth around base of trees around camp where tractor cannot cut.
5. Trim trees above tractor safety-bar.
6. Repair water leaks by cabins and Roquemore Pavilion.
7. Stump grinding (by an adult).
8. Trim and prune at trails.
9. Clean up Webelos area.
10. Thoroughly clean and pressure wash all restroom/shower facilities.
11. Pressure wash Ranger House
12. Pressure wash Copeland Center
13. Clean Copeland Center Bathrooms, Floors, Kitchen, Windows and Blinds.
14. Clean Vulcan Pavilion upstairs, kitchen and bathrooms.
15. Clean Cabins at the Lake.
16. Clean/mow/trim chapel, remove down limbs.
17. Clean campsite latrines
18. Clean Rifle & Shotgun Range and repair any broken boards on the fence.
19. Clean each sign in camp
20. Clear Amphitheater Area of limbs and weeds. Inspect each bench and repair.
21. Repair underground water line to the Cabins at the lake.
