

## Calling all Webelos in the Daniel Boone Council

### It will be **WILD** as the “**Critters Go Camping**” at Camp Daniel Boone



**WHEN:** Our “Wild Fun” weekend” runs July 28-30 Check-in is either Friday night 5pm-7pm or Saturday morning 8:30-9:30am Scouts are responsible for their own meals (purchasing and cooking) with the exception of Saturday lunch which is provided. This is a great opportunity for Webelos to work on their Cast Iron Chef adventure pin. Packs should arrive together and designate a vehicle to haul your gear to the campsite. Bringing a trailer is acceptable and the trailer can stay near your campsite; all vehicles must be moved to parking area.



**WHERE:** Camp Daniel Boone. Sumer Camp will still be set up so no need to bring tents.

**WHO:** Rising 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade Webelos are strongly encouraged to attend this event rather than the Fall Cub/Parent Weekend. There will be more to do with fewer people, and it really gives the scouts a “jump” start on the Scouts BSA program. Arrow of Light scouts will have an opportunity to go on a special creek hike. We’re sorry this program is for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> graders only.

**COST:** Only \$50 for youth and includes t-shirt, patch, program materials, Saturday lunch and snack. Adult fee is \$35 (includes lunch) with an optional \$12 for a t-shirt. Please register on-line at [danielboonecouncil.org](http://danielboonecouncil.org).

**WHAT ELSE:** Please register as a Pack on the form provided-you do so on-line or use a hard copy and send it to the Asheville Council Office. **Everyone** in attendance must complete parts A & B of a Medical Form (3 pages), be sure to fill in completely and sign.

Parents do not have to come with the boys, but **some adult leadership is expected from the Pack.** **ALL adults must have a current Youth Protection card.**

**TRADING POST:** We will sell Scout type items during scheduled hours.

**REGISTRATION:** Early registration includes a t-shirt (for youth) & patch (all); late registration cannot guarantee a patch or a t-shirt. Fees include Saturday lunch which is provided.

**Early Registration** must be postmarked by July 3. **Late Registration** is from July 3-July 10 and **must** include a \$15 late fee. **No** registration accepted after July 10. **Everyone registers together on the Unit Registration Form available on [danielboonecouncil.org](http://danielboonecouncil.org)**

Extra shoes (flip-flops or sandals for shower use only)

**Tennis shoes** for creek walking – 5<sup>th</sup> grade only

Flashlight and batteries

Toiletries (sunscreen, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, bug spray)

Water bottle with name

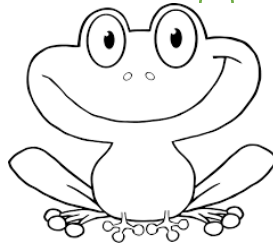
Camera if you wish
