

➔ Identification Wristbands

Each camper will be issued identification wristbands when they check in to camp. Camp visitors will be issued special wrist bands when they checkin at the office.

➔ Arriving at Camp - Your First Day

Units may begin arriving at camp from 1:00 pm through 3:00 pm. Each unit **MUST** contact the Camp Office to schedule a check-in time the week prior. When you arrive at camp you must wait in the parking lot until your check-in time. Units are NOT allowed to proceed independently to their campsites before check-in commences.

➔ Checking in to Camp

When you arrive at Camp Bud Schiele, drive to the parking lot and park. One unit leader will need to meet with a staff person. The rest of the unit will need to get out and prepare for the picture. The unit leader should have all adult leader's youth protection available. Our staff will provide the leader with a roster printed from the online registration system. The leader will make sure that the information is accurate and includes the names of all youth AND adults staying at camp.

The unit will then have their picture taken. To help make the process smooth, line up the youth according to height. Scoutmasters can hand the photo order form to the photographer. Payment should be given along with the form. If needed, the photo payment can be added with the camp balance to be settled on Tuesday. After the picture, all scouts and leaders can get back in the vehicle and drive straight to the campsite using your camp map.

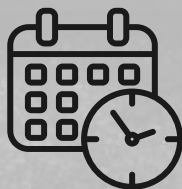
When you arrive at the campsite, your troop guide will be waiting for you. They will assign the tents for your unit, provide you with identification armbands, your merit badge schedules, schedule for the week, fireguard chart, and other pertinent information. They will do a quick inspection to make sure you have everything you need in the site. If your unit is taking the swim test at camp, the first thing to do after getting tents assigned is to change in preparation for the test.

Once the inspection is complete and the unit is ready, a staff member will take the unit through camp for a camp tour. They will show the different areas of camp like program areas, locations where special events occur, the Trading Post, and other areas. The next step is to complete a follow-up medical screening.

After the screening is complete, your unit will receive a refresher course on dining hall procedures from the dining hall staff and a talk from the shooting sports team. Then you will head to the waterfront for a safety briefing and your swim test (if needed).

After you have finished at the waterfront, you may then proceed to your campsite to finish setting up camp. "A" dinner service begins at 5:55. and assembly is at 6:30 pm. "B" dinner begins immediately after assembly. At 7:30 p.m. in the OA Shelter will be a mandatory Scoutmaster and Senior Patrol Leader meeting.

At 8:15 p.m. all scouts and adult leaders will participate in a mandatory General Alarm Drill. Following the drill, the camp staff will host the campfire program and officially welcome your unit to Camp Bud Schiele.
